

New opportunities for businesses: Slovenia

The Republic of Slovenia (Slovene: Republika Slovenija) is an independent state in central Europe, bordered on the west by Italy, with Austria to the north, east and south with Hungary with Croatia; It faces south-west of the Adriatic Sea (Gulf of Trieste). Its capital is Ljubljana. The territory is mostly mountainous; inward, bands of hills and plateaus alternate with flat areas. The climate is alpine, with cold winters except along the narrow coastal strip and the eastern region. The S. is characterized by considerable ethnic homogeneity that puts you on a different level than the variegated world Balkans: Slovenians represent 83.1% of the total population and no even among many minorities in the area has a consistency that to compete against the majority group: the Serbs, the most numerous, are just 2%; follow the Croats (1.8%), Bosnians (1.1%) and small groups of Hungarians, Albanians, Macedonians and Italian. The national language is Slovene, divided into numerous dialects, but in ethnically mixed regions are also spoken Italian and Hungarian. The strengths of Slovenia are:

The most frequent forms of companies in Slovenia are d.o.o. (S.r.l.), the d.d. (S.p.A.) and s.p. (Independent entrepreneur).
